Ancient Egypt was a low standing civilization in the North-Eastern Africa. It was concentrated along the middle to lower reaches of the Nile river. The civilization of ancient Egypt was based on balanced control of natural and human resources under the leadership of the Pharoah and his administrators, characterised by controlled irrigation of the fertile Nile valley, the mineral exploitation of the valley and surrounding desert regions.

Farming in Egypt was dependent upon the cycle of the Nile river. The Egyptians distinguished between three seasons, <u>which</u> they called Akhet(flooding), Peret(planting), and Shemu(harvesting). The flooding season was perfect for growing crops after the flood waters, farmers ploughed and planted seeds in the fields which were irrigated with lakes and canals. Egypt recycled little rainfall and farmers relied on the Nile to water their crops.

The last season was harvesting. Farmers would harvest the crops by cutting $\underline{\text{them}}$ down with sickles. Papyrus growing on the banks of the Nile river was used to make paper.

Vegetables and fruits were grown in garden plots closer to **their** habitations of higher ground and had to be watered by hand.
